Stark County High School Artists Featured

The Canton Museum of Art, supported by Kent State University Stark, Malone University and Walsh University, will present the annual Stark County High School Art Exhibition, March 23 through April 15, 2012. Admission is FREE.

The Stark County High School Art Exhibition provides an exciting opportunity for aspiring artists to have their work exhibited in an art museum setting. The exhibit features original two- and three-dimensional works by students from 19 Stark County high schools. All pieces presented are original works created as part of their school curriculums and chosen by the school's art instructor. Each school is limited to a total of ten entries with no more than two entries per artist. Student works are judged on the basis of both originality and technical ability.

The awards ceremony will be held on Tuesday, April 3rd, at a reception scheduled from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. Awards will be presented at 6:00 pm and light refreshments will be served. All are welcome to attend. College scholarship awards for the First, Second and Third Place recognition are \$1000, \$600 and \$400. Honorable mention awards will also be presented, with each winner receiving a scholarship for classes at the Museum of Art.
